The Ripley County Historical Society held their quarterly meeting October 13, 2024 at the Ripley County Historical Society Archives. Nineteen persons were present.

President Cheryl Welch called the meeting to order and led the attendees in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States of America.

The minutes from the last meeting were read by Owen Menchhofer in the absence of Secretary Barbara Eades. Owen Menchhofer presented the treasurer's reports and both were approved.

Old Business:

- Update was given on the archive renovations thanking all who volunteered with the project.
- Thank you to the Tyson fund for the floor joist repair grant which was received. Owen volunteered to move the books in the basement in the needed work area

New Business:

- Thank you to Southeastern REMC for the grant for the updates to the computer system.
- Owen explained the schedule of events for the Wreaths Across Ripley County. On Saturday,
 December 7 at 3 pm there will be the commemoration event on the Courthouse Square at the
 Veteran's Memorial for WARC. Since the date is Pearl Harbor Day the memory of John
 Raymond Stratton will be honored with the placement of a wreath by family members. Seaman
 first class Stratton was killed in the Japanese attack on the USS Arizona on December 7,
 1941. Veteran wreaths will be placed in county cemeteries on Saturday, December 14.
- The Main Street Versailles group will be holding their Home for the Holidays event on December 7. The Archives will have an open house for the community beginning at 5:30 pm to show off the updates to the building.
- Victor Sarringhause asked about the book progress. President Welch stated it is always a "waiting" response from Tracy at Winters Publishing since the project started in 2018.
- Dannie Welch asked about the updates on the website. Owen will check with Monica Hansen and Zach Menchhofer about this project.

Refreshments were provided by Cheryl Welch/Shelby Township in the absence of Washington Township director Gary Johnson. The next meeting will be Sunday, January 12, 2025 at the Central House in Napoleon. Victor Sarringhause will have the program about the Central House and its history.
